



COVID-19 Pandemic Data

Local COVID positivity rates for Cheshire have fallen over the past three months, since a peak experienced on January 14th (22.7% local positivity). However rates have ranged between 2% and 6% since a low (1.9%) experienced on March 3rd. This is consistent with trends seen statewide as the spike resulting from spread of the Omicron variant subsides, but local spread continues to fluctuate with community mitigation strategies relaxed. As of Monday, April 11th, our local estimated positivity rate over the past seven DPH reporting days was <u>5.3%</u> (64 positives in Cheshire out of 1,210 tests and up from 2.3% last month). The rolling 3-day average of this reported metric (yellow line) is currently <u>4.6%</u> (up from 2.1% last month).




Local case rates in Cheshire have moved from the "Orange" DPH alert level to the "Yellow" level with 8.6 daily cases per 100k population (down from 13.1 cases last month) as of April 7th.



To date, 87.42% of Cheshire residents of all ages have received at least one vaccination dose, an increase of 0.88% over last month (86.54).

Blight Ordinance Update

To date, twelve (12) properties have been cited under the Town's recently adopted blight ordinance. One property has been successfully remediated and the case has been closed, while three have appealed their citation.

Memorial Day Parade

The Cheshire Veteran's Council and Town of Cheshire staff have been meeting to discuss plans for this year's Memorial Day parade. Tentatively the parade is planned for Sunday, May 29th at 1:30pm. Groups looking to participate in the parade have until April 30th to confirm and so far based on the number of responses it appears the parade will very likely be able to follow the traditional route from Highland School to Bartlem Park.

Travelling Vietnam Wall

As a reminder, the Town of Cheshire is proud to be partnering with the Because of the Brave Foundation to bring the Travelling Vietnam Memorial Wall to Bartlem Park June 2nd-June 6th. The Travelling Wall is a 3/5 size replica of the Vietnam Memorial that stretches almost 300 feet from end to end. DPW and Recreation worked to identify a location toward the outfield of the softball fields at Bartlem Park. This is sure to be a great weekend for our town and opportunity to showcase Cheshire's legacy of honoring our veterans and those who sacrificed their lives for our country.

Veterans Memorial Plaza

Veterans who have not been included in the Town of Cheshire's Veterans Memorial Plaza located on the grounds of the Town Hall are encouraged to complete an application. To be included on the memorial must have been a Cheshire resident at the time of their enlistment. Completed applications must be received by close of business on Monday, April 18, 2022.

Grass Clippings and Leaf Disposal

The Town will be providing a container at 1304 Waterbury Road (adjacent to the Town Garage) for disposal of residential grass clippings and leaves.

The container will be accessible from 7:30-8:30 AM every Monday morning beginning Monday, May 2, 2022 and continuing through Monday, October 31, 2022 (excluding Memorial Day, July 4th [2022 only], Labor Day, and Columbus Day).
