- Pool Landscaping Redesign and implementation
- Planted and maintained planters on West Main Street and Town Hall
- Installed Holiday Decorations at Town Hall & Library including winter greens in planters at Town Hall and West Main Street streetscape
- Attendance at Home Health & Garden Show in April. Booth contained area for children to plant their own annuals and house plants. Provided information on Town beautification efforts.
- Facilitated Legal Agreement and provided mulch etc. to the Cheshire West Community Butterfly Garden at West Main Street and Lock 12 / Brooksvale area.
- Town Beautification Plan / Design Guidelines review with plans to revise in 2023
- West Main Street Business District Review for future plantings, holiday lighting program and façade improvement
- Town Hall Landscape Review / Memorial Plaza for future year implementation
- Bradford Pear Trimming along Route 10 - South from Town Center to Hamden Town Line. Reviewed Town's efforts for trimming and had several trees removed. Reviewed future street tree planting for Route 10.
- Welcome to Cheshire Sign designed and installed at 1681 Waterbury Road. Solicited quotes for repainting of Welcome sign at 691.
- Reviewed condition of Route 10 Parklets. Priority will be given to refresh parklets and work with DPW in 2023 to repair / operate irrigation systems and install annual plantings
- Planted Street Trees at Cheshire Park
- Reviewed "Right Tree – Right Place Standards," for future Route 10 street trees
- Reviewed and made suggestions to the proposed Native only planting policy on Town properties
- Modern Tire Island – Tree removed with new perennials scheduled to be planted in spring of 2023
- Tree pruning at Main Street / Route 10 parklet
- Library Landscaping renovation management and oversight of private contractor
- Site Plan / Planting Plan Review – Lot 3 Stone Bridge Crossing Eastpoint Development
- Planned landscape design and solicited quotes for Gateway Parklet Renovation at Maple Avenue and Route 10
- Rewrite of Bylaws to capture language in Town Ordinance – filed with Town Clerk to ensure continuity
