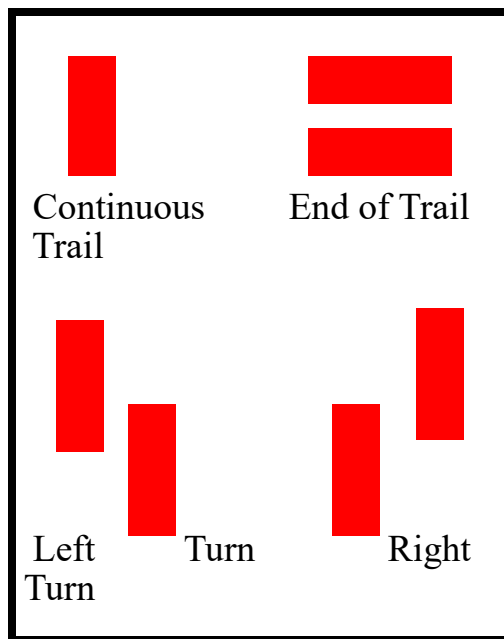


# Trail Blaze Guide

Roaring Brook, recognized as Connecticut's highest single drop waterfall at 80 feet, is protected and accessible due to public and private property owner partnership.

The steep Orange Trail ascends along Roaring Brook and terminates at the Quinipiac Blue Trail.

Please respect this open space property by keeping the area clear of trash and leaving plants and animals undisturbed in their natural habitat.

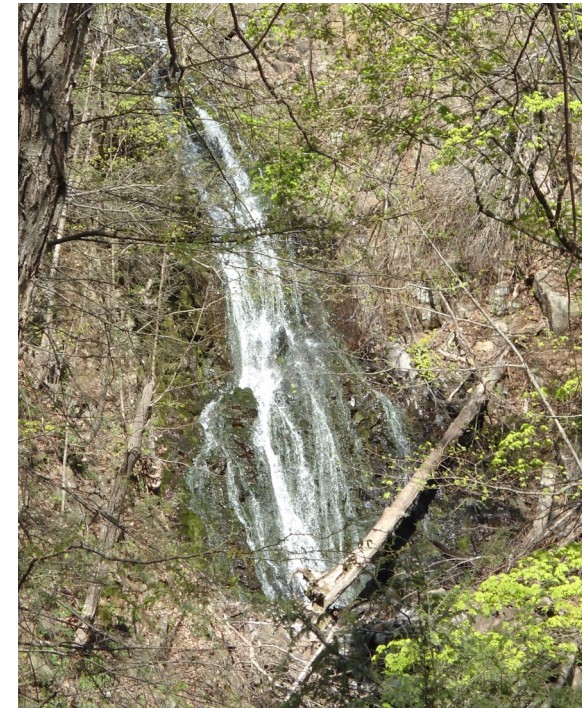
