Quinnipiac Park is also accessible by canoe and kayak from the State boat launch located on Route 322, across from the Southington Drive-In.

The Town of Cheshire, Town of Southington and the Quinnipiac River Watershed Association often host paddle events along the Quinnipiac River. Please check the organizations websites for current information.

Trees found in the 30-acre wooded forest of Quinnipiac Park include beech, eastern hemlock, red and white oak, and quaking aspen. The river banks are populated by tree species that have adapted to the seasonal flooding, such as; red and green ash, American sycamore, silver maple, and slippery elm.






